

Anca Ditroi is an Israeli Clinical Psychologist and supervisor, a psychoanalytically intersubjective psychotherapist and a group analytically oriented therapist. She works in her private practice , previously a training institute for clinical psychologists in individual and group psychoanalytic psychotherapy. She is an active member of GASi, of the Israeli Group Psychotherapy Association and of the IIGA (assoc. member).

She is a lecturer at Tel Aviv University in the core program and in the psychoanalytical group psychotherapy track of the Psychotherapy School at the Faculty of medicine.
