Chana Ullman is a Clinical Psychologist, a Training Psychoanalyst and faculty at the Tel Aviv Institute of Contemporary Psychoanalysis. A former president of the institute. Dr. Ullman is faculty and supervisor at the relational track, the school of Psychotherapy, Sackler school of Medicine at Tel-Aviv University, and faculty at the doctoral program of Psychoanalysis at Tel Aviv University. She is past- president of the International Association of Relational Psychoanalysis and Psychotherapy. Dr. Ullman currently co-director (with Prof. Aner Govrin) of the psychoanalytic psychotherapy program at Tel Aviv institute of contemporary Psychoanalysis.

She is the author of the book "The transformed self: The psychology of religious conversion" (Plenum press, 1989) and of numerous publications regarding witnessing, political context and the relational perspective on psychoanalytic process.
